

## Transition advice for qualifications

In implementing the WRB04 Beauty Training Package there are a number of considerations impacting on RTOs in relation to mutual recognition and scope of registration. The following table provides advice on the relationship between qualifications from WRB99 and WRB04.

WRB50199 Diploma of Beauty Therapy	WRB50104 Diploma of Beauty Therapy	<p>WRB50104 replaces WRB50199 as the intent remains unchanged.</p> <p>The total number of units required to achieve this qualification has been increased, from 29 to 33:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The number of core units required has not changed</li> <li>• The number of elective units required has increased, from 6 to 10</li> </ul> <p>Six units of competency which overtly address the application of anatomy and physiology, skin science, skin biology, electricity, nutrition, cosmetic chemistry and nail science to beauty therapy treatments have been included in the core. One which overtly addresses application of nail science to nail treatments is included in the elective bank which has been expanded, particularly in relation to beauty specific units of competency.</p>
