<i>Definitions and Explanation of Report</i>	
Original Application Approved	An IVETS (Integrated Vocational Education and Training System) status of approved indicates that a DET (Department of Education and Training) ITA (Industry Training Assistant) has approved the Training Arrangement application. An original application is one that has previously not been approved for an individual in a given vocation.
Vocational Training Order	The VTO (Vocational Training Order) is a document detailing the training guidelines for a traineeship or apprenticeship. The VTO forms the basis of the training contract between the employer and the apprentice/trainee and identifies the structured training and qualification they will receive.
Trainee Apprentice	An apprenticeship is a job which usually combines college study with on-the-job training, to learn a trade or craft. A trainee apprenticeship is not available in all trades, does not involve a written contract (indenture) and the employment may be terminated by either party by giving the prescribed notice.
Apprenticeship	Apprentices other than trainee apprentices sign an indenture which is a written contract of training between an employer and apprentice.
Approvals Pending	This status indicates that the Training Arrangement application has not yet been approved by the DET ITA.
Financial and Calendar year figures represent approvals granted up until the the last date of the period of the report while last Financial year and last Calendar year figures represent the corresponding period for the previous year.
