

MEA07 Aeroskills (revised)

Members of the National Quality Council endorsed the revised MEA07 Aeroskills Training Package, out of session on 14 November 2007 and the National Quality Council decision was approved by the Ministerial delegate on 30 November 2007.

The MEA07 Aeroskills (revised) Training Package qualifications were accredited by VETAB on 10 December 2007.

The Aeroskills Training Package covers aviation maintenance activities performed by:

- Civil aviation maintenance organisations operating under the Civil Aviation Safety Authority (CASA) airworthiness regulatory system, including major airlines, regional airlines, general aviation bodies, third party aircraft maintenance organisations and component maintenance organisations; and
- Australian Defence Force (ADF) aviation maintenance organisations that are operating within the ADF airworthiness regulatory system, including the three Defence Forces and civilian contractors maintaining ADF aircraft and aircraft components.

The MEA97 Training Package was endorsed in September 1997 and covered the occupational fields of avionics, mechanical and structures of the aircrafts.

The revised MEA07 Aeroskills Training Package integrates the CASA licensing requirements and transitional arrangements now available and specified in Civil Aviation Order (CAO) 100.66. This CAO enables industry to access licensing arrangements for specific type aircraft (types operated by airlines) that have been aligned with the European Aviation Safety Agency licensing system.

Appropriate adjustments have been made to units of competency and training pathways to accommodate these new CASA licensing arrangements.

In addition, in the MEA07, the Aircraft Surface Finishing occupational field has been covered at Certificates II, III and IV levels. Coverage in the Avionics, Mechanical and Structures fields has also been further extended to cover the highly specialised and regulated maintenance management area at Diploma and Advanced Diploma levels under both the CASA and ADF airworthiness regulatory systems.

CASA, QANTAS and the National Aeroskills Registered Training Organisations Community of Practice Network supported the endorsement of the revised MEA07 Training Package.
