

PRM04 Asset Maintenance – Addition – Fire Protection Equipment

The PRM04 Asset Maintenance Training Package was re-endorsed in March 2004 to replace the initial PRM98 Training Package.

The category 2 changes for this PRM04 Training Package involve the revision of current units of competency, development of new units and changing units and qualification codes.

The Commonwealth Department of Environment and Heritage worked closely with the Fire Protection Association to develop regulations to cover the management of ozone depleting substances and synthetic greenhouse gases used in the fire protection industry.

To reflect the regulations, the Construction and Property Services Industry Skills Council (CPSISC) redeveloped six units of competency from the endorsed Fire Protection Equipment sector of the PRM04 Asset Maintenance Training Package. These units were revised to meet the regulator's requirements in terms of the handling licenses for ozone depleting substances and synthetic greenhouse gases.

The CPSISC also developed ten new units to support the regulations and they have been added to the elective pool of the two revised qualifications.

Because of the change in coding of some core units of competency in the qualifications, the current PRM20404 Certificate II and PRM30404 Certificate III in Asset Maintenance (Fire Protection Equipment) have been assigned new qualification codes as PRM20406 Certificate II in Asset Maintenance (Fire Protection Equipment) and PRM30406 Certificate III in Asset Maintenance (Fire Protection Equipment).

PRM30406 Certificate III in Asset Maintenance (Fire Protection Equipment)
