

TDA03 Aviation (amendments)

The TDA03 Aviation Training Package was developed and endorsed in March 2003. The full review of this Training Package is expected to be completed by the end of 2007.

Proposed category 2 changes are:

- Create two new qualifications with clear and distinct streams for licensed occupations ie Commercial Pilot Aeroplane Licence, Commercial Pilot Helicopter Licence within the Aviation industry. They meet both industry and licensing standards;
- The packaging rules have been simplified and the removal of units which do not contribute to occupational outcomes for commercial pilots.
- New qualifications have titles as "Aviation Operations" to more accurately reflect the Aviation industry.
- The two new qualifications will replace the current TDA40203 Certificate IV in Transport and Distribution (Aviation Flight Operations).

Transport and Logistics Industry Skills Council provided written evidence of support received from the industry, various flight training organisations and regulatory body.

The amendments were considered by DEST and all State/Territory Training Authorities representatives on 31 May 2007 and all issues raised have been resolved.

Members of the National Quality Council endorsed the amendments, out of session on 6 August 2007.

The amendments to the TDA03 Aviation Training Package were approved by Ministers on 23 August 2007.
