

WRB04 Beauty Training Package (Category 2 change to the Certificate IV and Diploma of Beauty Therapy)

The WRB04 Beauty Training Package was endorsed in June 2004. Since the review, some anomalies have come to light through a project on nominal hours. As a result, it is proposed that the weightings attached to some of the units of competency in the WRB40104 Certificate IV in Beauty Therapy and the WRB50104 Diploma of Beauty Therapy, be modified in order to maintain comparable effort across the various qualification streams.

The units to be modified are all elective units and while the modifications do not involve a change to the units themselves, however, they do affect the packaging of the qualifications. Because of this, new codes are assigned to the two qualifications:

- WRB40105 Certificate IV in Beauty; and
- WRB50105 Diploma of Beauty Therapy.

As a result of this category 2 change:

A. New qualification codes are given to the qualifications ie WRB40104 to WRB40105 and WRB50104 to WRB50105.

B. In the Certificate IV in Beauty Therapy, the amendment is:

- The three units BSZ401A, BSZ402A and BSZ403A must be undertaken together and will together equate to 1 unit. (previously no clear statement regarding the weighting and togetherness).

C. In the Diploma of Beauty Therapy, the amendments are:

- The following unit will count as 1 unit:
 - WRBSS504B Perform diathermy service (previously count as 4 units)
- The following unit will count as 2 units:
 - WRBBS510A Provide spa program (previously count as 1 unit)
- The following units will count as 3 units:
 - WRBSS503B Provide permanent epilation (previously count as 4 units)
 - WRBSS505B Design and perform cosmetic tattooing/micropigmentation procedures (previously count as 4 units)
 - CUEMUP2A Design, apply and remove priod make-up (previously count as 1 unit)
 - CUEMUP3A Design, apply and remove specialist make-up (previously count as 1 unit)

- HLTREM6A Provide the massage treatment (previously count as 1 unit)
 - The three units BSZ401A, BSZ402A and BSZ403A must be undertaken together and will together equate to 1 unit. (previously no clear statement regarding the weighting and togetherness).
- D. As the overall outcomes of the qualifications do not change, the old qualifications are deemed equivalent to the new ones. As this, old qualifications will be roll overed to the new ones after being endorsed. The 1 year transition period also applies.
