

FITNESS INDUSTRY TRAINING PACKAGE & COMMUNITY RECREATION TRAINING PACKAGE

The reviewed Fitness Industry Training Package and Community Recreation Training Package have been received from Sport & Recreation Training Australia (SRTA) for submission to the National Training Quality Council (NTQC). In accordance with the currently agreed process, the Packages and Endorsement Submission report have been forwarded to you under separate cover for your comments before submission to the NTQC for endorsement consideration.

The Fitness Industry Training Package and Community Recreation Training Package were endorsed by the NTQC in December 2000. The Packages have not been amended since their original endorsement.

The phase I joint review report (the findings of which formed the basis of phase II redevelopment) was circulated to STAs before being submitted to the NTQC in December 2002. All but two of the recommendations from the phase I report have been implemented in phase II. The two recommendations that were not adopted were the inclusion of Yoga and Pilates competencies in the Fitness Training Package.

Structurally within the Fitness Industry Training Package, Certificate II in Fitness has been removed as it was considered there was no vocational outcome: relevant units have been incorporated into Certificate II in Community Recreation. New entrants to the fitness industry with no previous experience can pick up relevant units that have been moved to the Certificate II in Community Recreation as electives when doing the Certificate III in Fitness. The Diploma of Fitness is a new qualification.

Structurally within the Community Recreation Training Package, Certificate III in Community Recreation and Certificate III in Community Recreation (Instruct) have been integrated into a single qualification, although the ability for students to specialise in instruction has been retained. The Diploma of Community Recreation has been removed as it was considered too similar to the Diploma of Sport and Recreation. These two qualifications were identical with the exception of four units of competency. These four units have been transferred to the Certificate IV in Community Recreation.

Assessment Guidelines are complete but require single assessors to have a current knowledge of the industry, industry practices and the job or role against which performance is being assessed. Where assessment is undertaken in conjunction with a workplace supervisor, in partnership with a technical expert, or using a panel arrangement, it is a requirement that the workplace supervisor, technical advisor or at least one panel member has a current knowledge of the industry, industry practices and the job or role

against which performance is being assessed. This requirement exceeds Standard 7 of the Australian Quality Training Framework (AQTF) *Standards for RTOs*. The developer has detailed the rationale for the increased assessor qualifications in the Endorsement Submission report. NTQC endorsement of these requirements has previously been given with endorsement of the revised Sport Industry Training Package (SRS02) and Outdoor Recreation Training Package (SRO02).
